### A Message from Our Pastor

Saying the wrong thing can get a person in a lot of trouble. You may have heard the story of the man who purchased a horse that formerly belonged to a preacher. In order to make the horse go, the command, "Praise the Lord," had to be given. To stop the horse, "Hallelujah!" was the instruction. The purchaser did all right in getting the horse started. "Praise the Lord!" he shouted. The horse took off at a full gallop and headed for a cliff. "Whoa!" the man shouted, but to no avail. Suddenly he realized he had forgotten the command to stop the horse. Just in the nick of time he remembered. "Hallelujah!" The horse came to a stop at the very edge of the cliff, so that its new owner could look into the chasm below. The man with great excitement and relief shouted, "Praise the Lord!"

Saying the wrong thing can get you into trouble, but doing the right thing in the right way never will. Doing the right thing may be hard, but it will always please the Lord.
